

The ladybug is a type of beetle. Most ladybugs have oval shaped bodies with six short legs. Seven-spot ladybugs have seven red or orange spots. There are three spots on each side of its body and one in the middle.


Ladybugs lay their eggs in rows on the underside of a leaf. The eggs hatch in a few days and out comes the larvae. The larvae are long, black and spiky-looking with orange or yellow spots. Some say they look like tiny alligators. The larvae grow quickly as they gobble up other tiny insects. When they reach the full size, they attach themselves to a leaf by their tail and a pupa is formed. Within a week or two, the pupa becomes an adult ladybug.

As adults, most ladybugs live up to one year. Farmers love them because they eat many insects that are harmful to plants. If they have enough food, they will mate and lay eggs, continuing their life cycle in the garden.

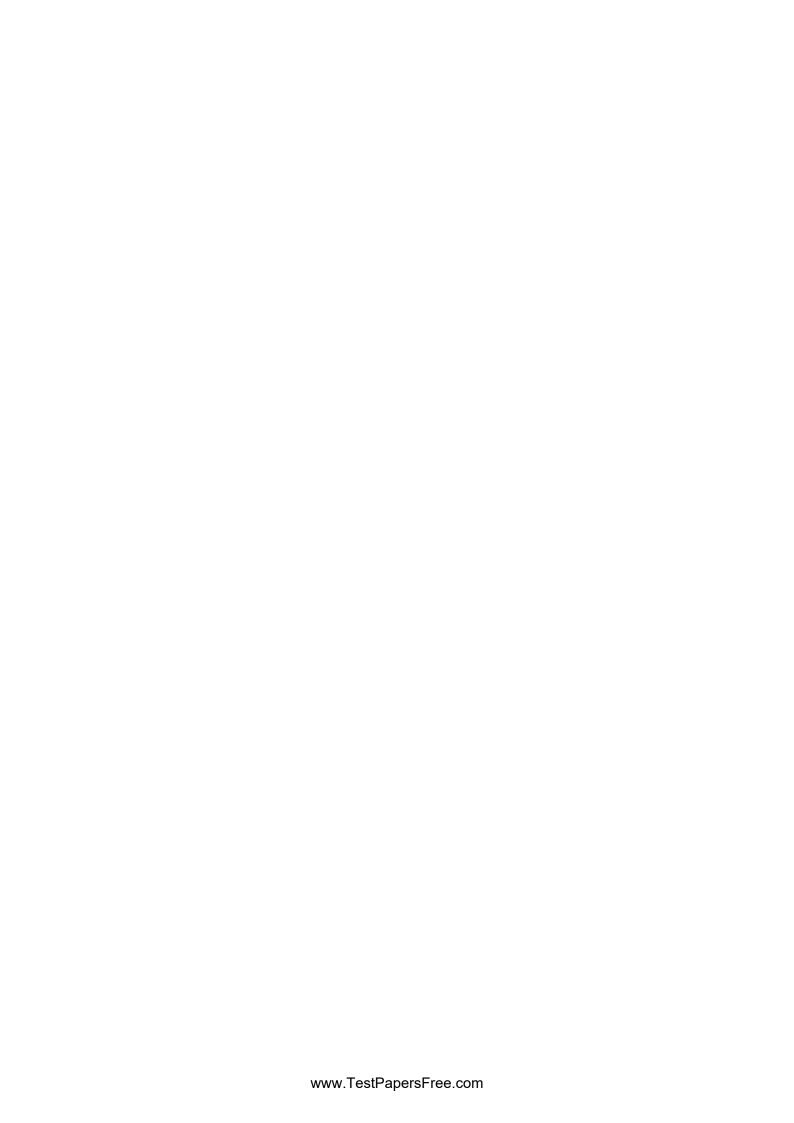
