

Nowadays, everyone is buying eco-friendly air-conditioners. However, their impact on carbon footprint may be limited. To mislead consumers into believing they are making a difference, companies often highlight the efficiency of eco-friendly air-conditioners without evidence of long-term energy saving.

Consumers can turn to advertising campaigns to decide which air-conditioners to purchase. However, to make an informed choice, consumers should look beyond such campaigns and refer to official energy ratings, certifications and independent reviews as more reliable sources of information. They help consumers consider how much energy the products really save, how long they will last, and how much maintenance they will require.
