The police said that the body of the 51-year-old was found floating ten metres away from the shore. Upon arrival, the paramedics examined the body and later pronounced him dead at 7.41 pm. It was reported that the man was reeling in what was believed to be a large fish when he lost his balance and fell into the sea. His friend suffered cuts on his right leg when he tried to pull the victim to safety but failed. 10

Ali, who has been fishing at the jetty during his free time, said it was generally safe to fish there. He commented that if a fish is too heavy, one should cut the fishing line for safety reasons if one cannot manage to pull the fish out of the water. 15
